

# COVERED IMMUNIZATIONS

## EXPANDED IMMUNIZATION COVERAGE

In the past, your Central Laborers' Welfare Fund provided coverage, under the benefit Adult Wellness and the Well Child Benefit, for immunizations required for attendance at a daycare center or school. Effective January 1, 2018, those benefits have been expanded to include the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Recommended Age appropriate immunizations. Although some physicians may recommend additional prophylactic vaccines on alternate schedules, the Fund will utilize the commonly recognized standard immunization lists published by the CDC when applying benefits. Allowable immunizations are based on the CDC's age appropriate immunization recommendations.

NOTE: Fees to administer the immunizations are excluded under Plan Exclusion #25

### NOTE –

- 1) If an immunization is being given outside the CDC's recommended age range and is being given as a "catch up" immunization or due to a high risk or immunocompromised diagnosis, a medical necessity statement will need to be sent to the Fund Office and prior authorization issued for that immunization to be covered.
- 2) Fees to administer the immunizations are not covered. They are not payable based on exclusion #25.
